



Performance Data 2024

Key Stage 2

Children are awarded a scaled score in reading; grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) and maths, with 100 being the national average. Writing is assessed by the class teacher using national criteria.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic the government confirmed that it will not publish any school educational performance data based on test for 2020 or 2021. The publishing of data for 2022 is optional.

We provide here an overview of our Key Stage 2 (KS2) results for the academic year 2023/2024, which ended in July 2024. National Curriculum tests report results as 'scaled scores'. In order to meet the expected standard, children must achieve a scaled score of 100 or more in their tests. Children who achieve a scaled score of 110 and higher are considered to have a higher level of attainment. A key indicator in these results is how St Bernadette's Catholic Primary School compares with the National average and the Local Authority average.

Reading, writing and maths combined

The following table shows the percentage of pupils who achieved the expected standard or better in reading, writing and maths combined.
