Earth and Space

Describe the movement of the Earth and other planets
relative to the sun in the solar system; describe the
movement of the moon relative to the Earth; describe the
sun, Earth and moon as approximately spherical bodies; use
the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and
the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

Understand that the sun is a star at the centre of our solar
system and that it has 8 planets: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars,
Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune. Children should
understand that a moon is a celestial body that orbits a
planet.
